Geomarine Bursaries

Geomarine AS/A Level Bursary

To support a student, who has shown interest in a career in an Engineering or Geotechnical industry, and who will be studying AS/A levels with a view to proceeding to a related degree course.

Who can apply: Prospective first-year AS level students intending to continue to A levels and a degree course.

Value: Single payment of up to £500.00 to be spent on IT and £100 for text books per annum for two years.

Geomarine will also commit to assisting with arranging or facilitating work experience and ensuring sufficient advice is given to help the student make further career decisions.



Judging Criteria and Timings

May/June. Candidates who are currently in year 11 should send a short email to careers@geomarine.je with 'Geomarine AS/A level Bursary' as the subject title. In the correspondence, please state career interests, GCSEs being taken and intended AS/A level courses.

September. Interview. Proof of grades achieved and acceptance on AS level courses.

Geomarine Degree Bursary

To support a student who has taken A levels relevant to a career in a Civil Engineering or Geotechnical industry, and who has subsequently been accepted on a degree course in one of these areas.

Who can apply: Final year A level students, on receipt of acceptance to university.

Value: Single payment of up to £500.00 to be spent on IT and £225 for text books per annum for up to four years.



Geomarine will also commit to mentoring, providing personal connections within the industry, assisting with arranging or facilitating work experience and ensuring sufficient advice is given to help students make further career decisions.

Judging Criteria and Timings

May/June. Candidates in their final A level year, should email careers@geomarine.je with 'Geomarine AS/A level Bursary' as the subject title. Please describe career aspirations, A levels being taken and intended degree courses in the correspondence.

September. Interview. Proof of grades achieved and acceptance to university.
